GEOTRAP is an OECD/NEA Project devoted to radionuclide migration in geologic, heterogeneous media in the framework of site evaluation and safety assessment of deep repository systems for high-level and/or long-lived radioactive waste.

The first GEOTRAP workshop, "Field Tracer Experiments: Role in the Prediction of Radionuclide Migration" (Cologne, Germany, 28-30 August 1996) was co-organised with the European Commission. It gave an overview of on-going and planned work in the study of radionuclide transport phenomena and the characterisation of relevant properties of the geologic media.

In addition to the papers presented at the workshop, these proceedings include a synthesis of the materials presented, the discussions that took place and the conclusions drawn, notably during working group sessions.
