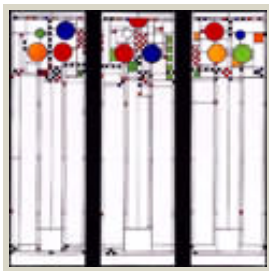

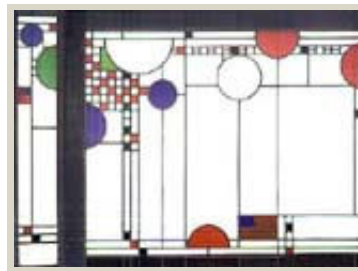
The Avery Coonley House was built in 1907-11. Then in 1911, Avery Coonley commissioned Wright to build a playhouse where Mrs. Coonley would use as a kindergarten. The Coonley Playhouse windows incorporate iconic images of a parade, including balloons, American flags and confetti. The designs used in these windows were artistically striking, adding brightly colored circles to Wright's usual selection of squares and rectangles.

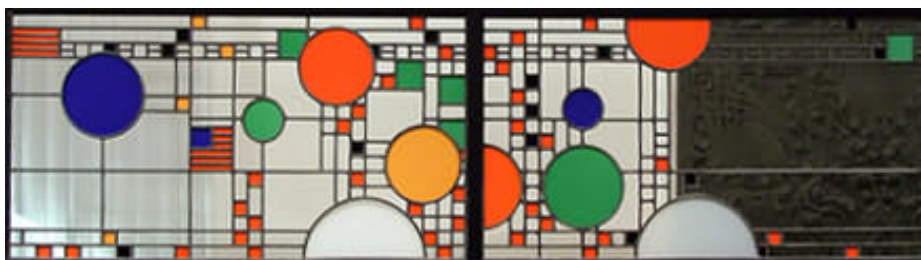

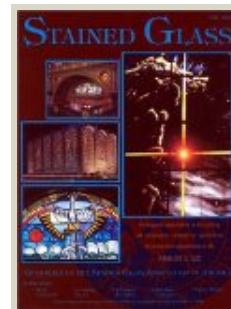

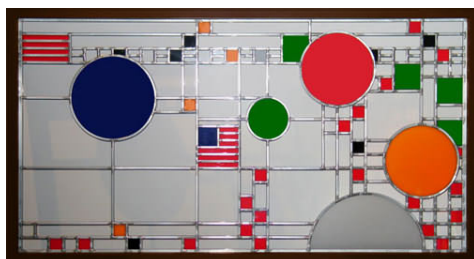

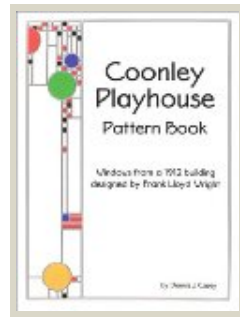
